Visual

Images, videos that represent the key themes of enquiry

EFFORT-METER — Quick &
accessible to curate, Easy to use



Tactile

Textures, fabrics, material swatches and objects that represent the key themes

SOURCE — local market, your home, neighbourhood and your friends' homes ;)

EFFORT-METER — Takes
considerable time and effort to
collect, carry and use



Auditory

Music, songs, dialogues, clips from advertisements, conversations, ambient sounds, tracks, film dialogues, commentary etc that represent the key themes.

SOURCE — Web portals, The world around you, Audio files

EFFORT-METER — Comparitively
time-taking to curate, Easy to use



Textual

Key words and phrases that represent the key themes

SOURCE — Your own vocabulary, Thesaurus, Research excerpts
